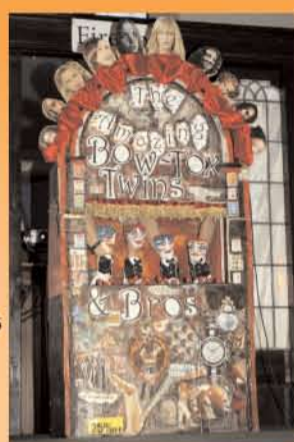
## Showcasing Event
