
Anwar Suliman, of the Cactus Club says "We can host business meetings, promotional Armer Salterior \* events, weddings, birthdays, parties,



# Frequently Asked Questions Business Rates

Am I entitled to any discount on my business rates bill? You may be entitled to Small Business Rate Relief, available to businesses with a rateable value of less than £15,000. Eligible businesses, with rateable values of below £5,000, can get 50% rate relief on their liability. This relief decreases on a sliding scale of 1%, for every £100 of rateable value over £5,000, up to £9,999. Businesses with rateable values of between £10,000 and £14,999, may also be eligible for discounts.
